## **Alabama Statistics PCSK9 Inhibitors**



## **About PCSK9 Inhibitors**

PCSK9 inhibitors are designed for patients with extremely high LDL, or "bad," cholesterol. The drugs are approved by the Food and Drug Administration to treat:

- Heterozygous familial hypercholesterolemia, an inherited condition that causes high levels of LDL cholesterol
- Clinical atherosclerotic cardiovascular disease, such as heart attacks or strokes.

A national data supplier reviewed PCSK9 inhibitor claims for managed care organizations in Alabama from January 2017 through December 2017.

Of health plans that received at least 100 claims for PCSK9 inhibitors, the following had the highest rates of rejections:

- BCBS Alabama 48%
- Express Scripts 37%

- CVS Health 45%
- Cigna Healthcare 33%

The following had the lowest rates of rejection:

Humana Health Plan 19%

State Employees Health Insurance SEHIP 8%





The following table details claims data for the Alabama managed care organizations that received at least 100 claims for PCSK9 inhibitors.
